RESPONSIBILITIES

Executive Leadership members are expected to help maintain order and structure within the base.

This includes:

- Ensuring members wear the correct uniform, badge, and motto while on duty.
- Monitoring that promotion procedures and timers are being followed correctly.
 - Providing guidance and assistance to staff members who require help.
- Supporting leadership teams in maintaining a professional and organized base environment.
- Observing base activity and encouraging members to remain active and engaged.

Promotion Authority

- As an Executive Leadership member, you may now promote staff members up to Assistant Divisional Leader. Always ensure that promotion procedures and timers are followed correctly before issuing a promotion.
- Executive Leadership members are eligible for their own promotion every 5 hours, provided that activity and performance standards are met.
